Carolyn Holman is the Coordinator for the Maricopa County Department of Public Health, Office of Oral Health Tobacco Use Prevention Program. She provides technical assistance and continuing education to dental and medical professionals so they can assist their patients in quitting tobacco use. Her ten years as coordinator, 14 years in private practice, and her previous experience as a clinical instructor in the Phoenix College Dental Hygiene Program provide valuable insight for adapting tobacco cessation intervention strategies in the dental practice environment.

Carolyn is certified as a Basic Tobacco Cessation Skills instructor by the HealthCare Partnership at The University of Arizona. She is the State liaison to the Arizona Dental Hygiene Association in their work with the national Smoking Cessation Initiative.

Carolyn is a recognized expert in training oral health professionals on tobacco, and she has presented at the national, state and local level.

Tobacco has a huge impact on oral health, and its use often results in poor dental outcomes and more time spent by the hygienist and dentist dealing with oral manifestations of tobacco. You may be ticked off by the stain, the periodontal disease, the oral cancer and of course, the smoker’s breath! So many people continue to be harmed by tobacco use.

There is so much you can do, so easily and so quickly, to help your patients quit! Alaska has a statewide tobacco prevention program that provides free services to those who are ready to quit. Learn how to:

- Define the dental professional’s role in tobacco prevention and cessation.
- Identify oral and systemic effects of tobacco use.
- Perform a brief intervention for tobacco cessation, and describe community resources to reduce the problem of tobacco use.

**“Bisphosphonate Induced Osteonecrosis of the Jaws”:**

Bisphosphonate induced osteonecrosis of the jaws was first identified in 2003. Since then, it has been described in medical and dental literature but is not well understood by many clinicians. This course will describe the disease mechanism and present some treatment strategies for patients at risk for or who present with bisphosphonate osteonecrosis of the jaws.
